



Humility is to know yourself as a part of Creation. In the Anishinaabe language, this word can also mean "compassion".

You are equal to others but you are not better.





Bravery

Bravery is to face the foe with integrity.

In the Anishinaabe language, this word literally means "state of having a fearless heart."

To do what is right even when the consequences are unpleasant.






Wisdom

To cherish knowledge is to know Wisdom. In the Anishinaabe language, this word expresses not only "wisdom," but also means "prudence," or "intelligence."

Wisdom is given by the Creator to be used for the good of the people.





Honesty

Honesty in facing a situation is to be brave. Always be honest in word and action. In the Anishinaabe language, this word can also mean "righteousness."

Be honest first with yourself, and you will more easily be able to be honest with others.








To know Love is to know peace. Love must be unconditional. In the language this indicates that this form of love is mutual.

When people are weak they need love the most.








To honour all creation is to have Respect. All of creation should be treated with respect.
